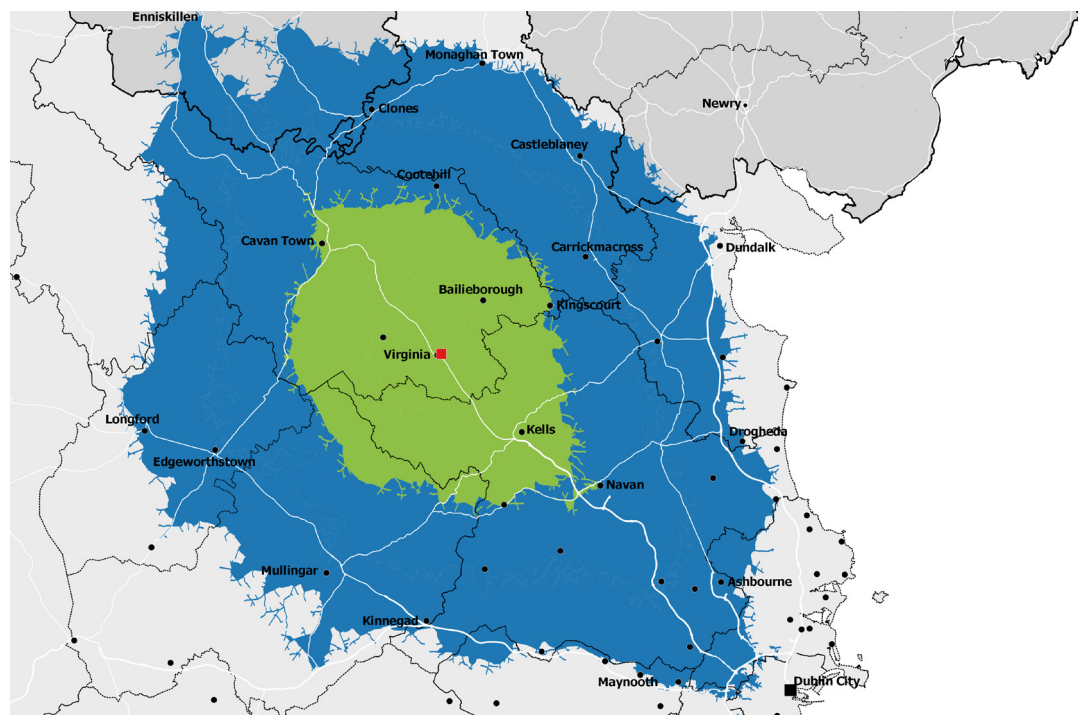
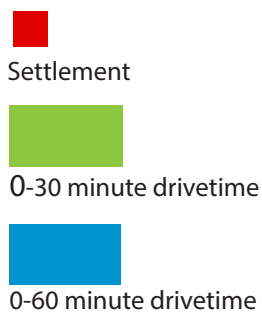
The socio-economic catchment profile (skills audit) is based on six key themes with a series of indicators representing each theme. All data is based on the latest available Census information and incorporates data from both Ireland and Northern Ireland (2016).

Each indicator page highlights the key points and provides three key graphics that illustrate the main data for either the hierarchy of geographies (settlement, 30 and 60 minutes catchment) or for the key indicators within the theme.



Geography

The socio-economic catchment profile is based on two distinct geographies. Firstly, the official settlement boundary for the town (based on Central Statistics Office definition) and secondly, a drive-time isochrone or travel catchment to each settlement. Two isochrones are represented here - a 0-30 minute travel isochrone and a one-hour travel isochrone (see green and blue areas below).

Within a one hour drivetime there is a total population of 627,406. This figure represents approximately 9.5% of the All-Island population (6.624M) in 2016.



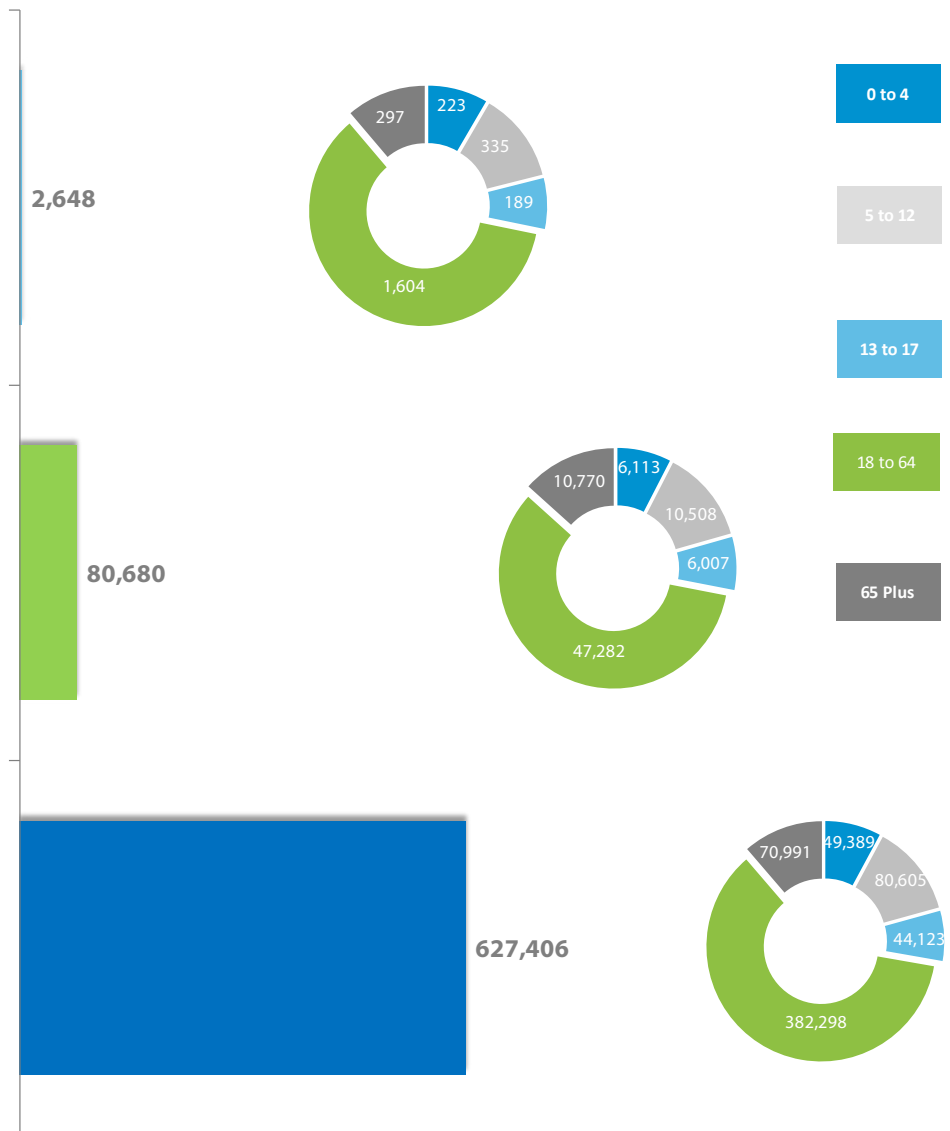

Within a one hour drivetime there is a total working age population of 410,002. This figure represents approximately 9.5% of the All-Island working age population (4.317M) in 2016.



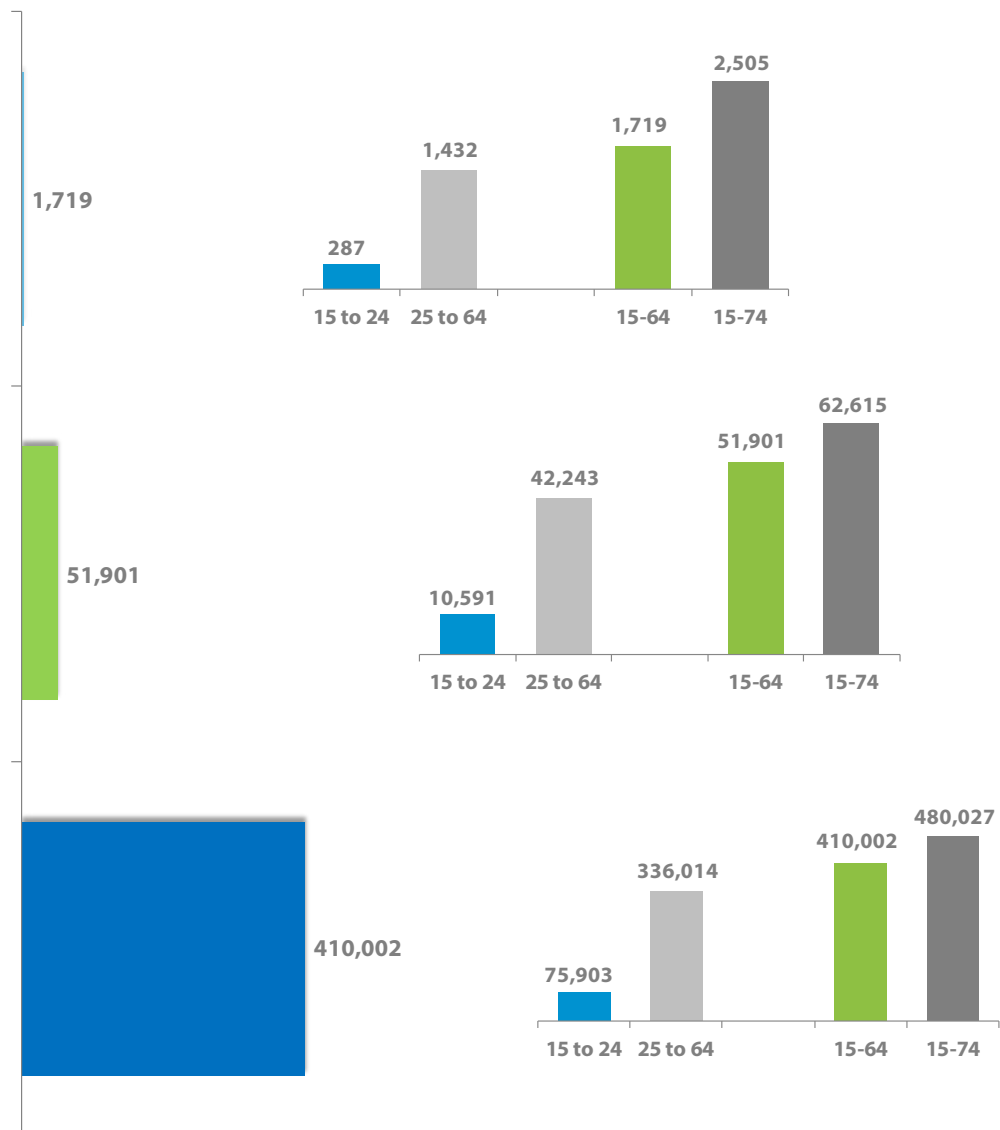

Virginia has a high number of people with Apprenticeships, Technical and Vocational qualifications residing within a one hour drive from the settlement.



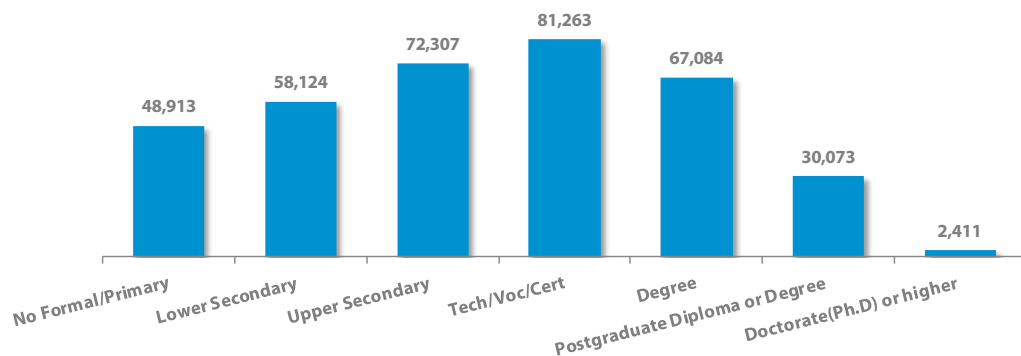
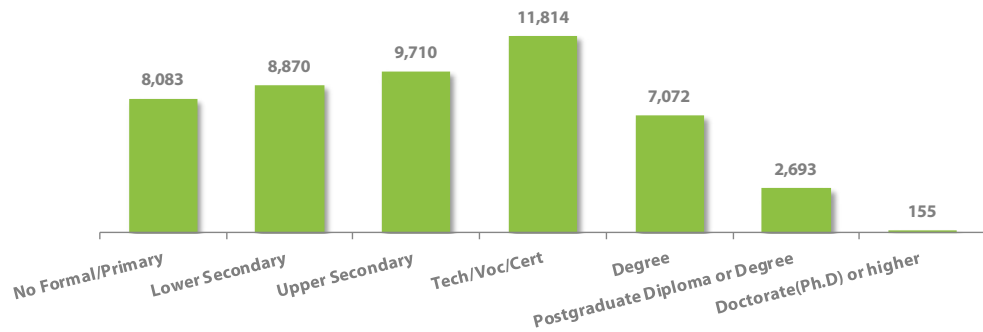
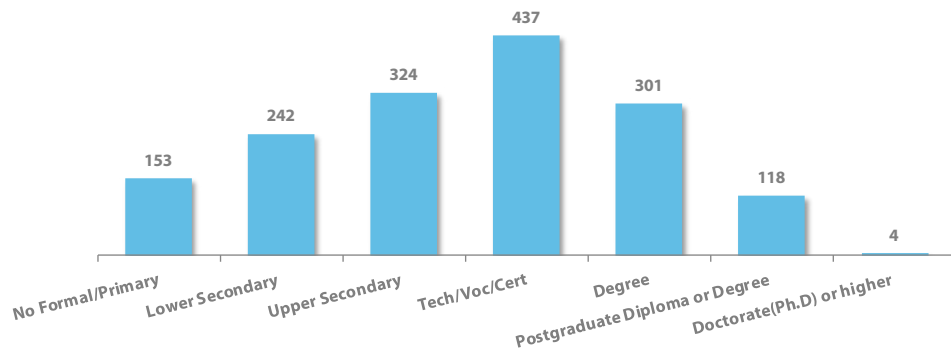

Of the 259,111 people at Work within a one hour drivetime, a total of 62,306 (24%) are employed in 'Commerce and Trade'. This figure is 6,408 (20.1%) within 30 minutes and 241 (22.2%) within the settlement.

Professional Services

Of the 259,111 people at Work within a one hour drivetime, a total of 58,651 (22.6%) are employed in 'Professional Services'. This figure is 6,646 (20.8%) within 30 minutes and 218 (20.1%) within the settlement.

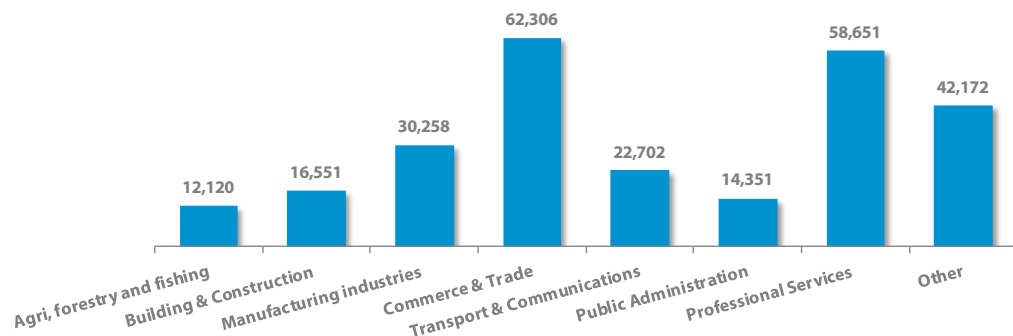
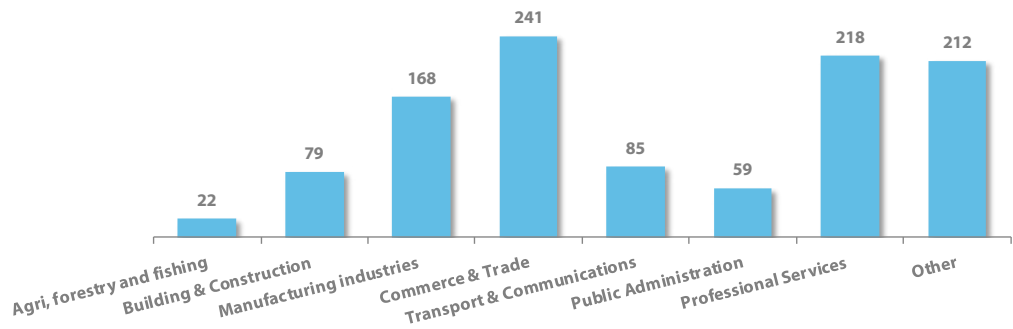

A total of 21,908 (7.4%) persons classed as 'Managers, Directors and Senior Officials' are residing within a one hour drivetime, 2,439 (6.6%) within 30 minutes and 85 (6.7%) within the Settlement.

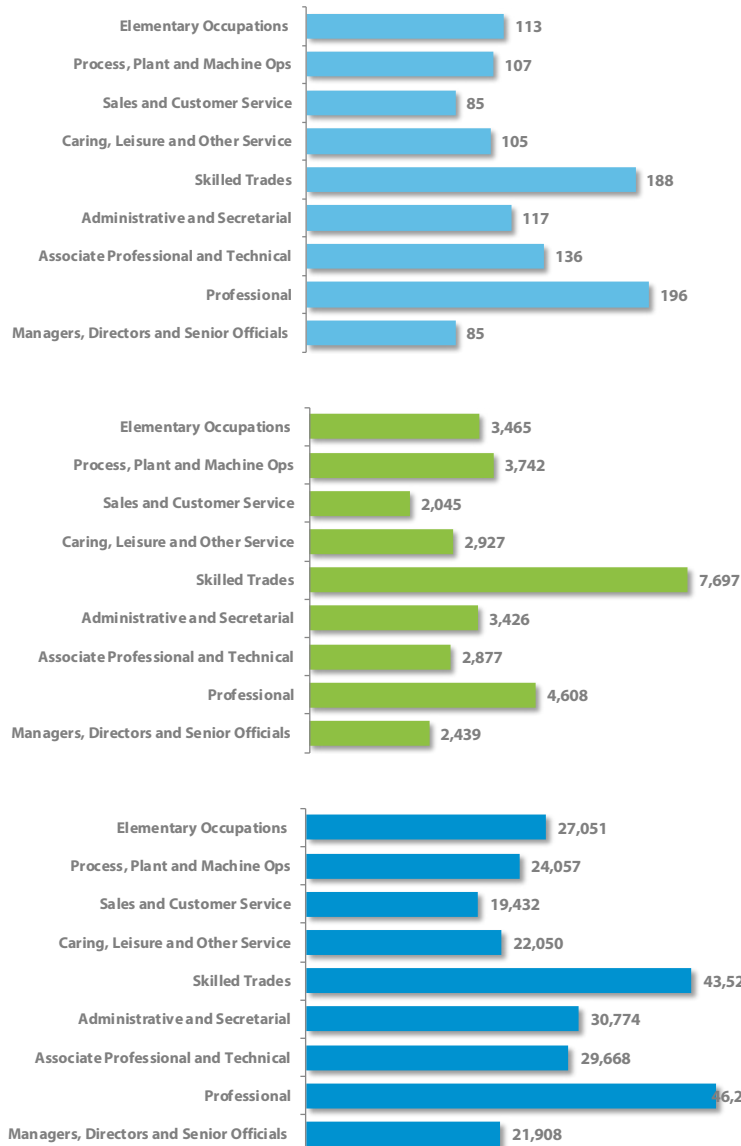

Non-native Language Speakers (RoI only)



99,447

Within a 60 minute drivetime a population of 99,447 are non-native language speakers. This can be broken down into Polish 19,727 (19.8%), French 6,027 (6.1%), Lithuanian 11,265 (11.3%) and Other 62,428 (62.8%).

Within a 30 minute drivetime a population of 9,226 are non-native language speakers. This can be broken down into Polish 2,230 (24.2%), French 646 (7%), Lithuanian 1,547 (16.8%) and Other 4,803 (52.1%).

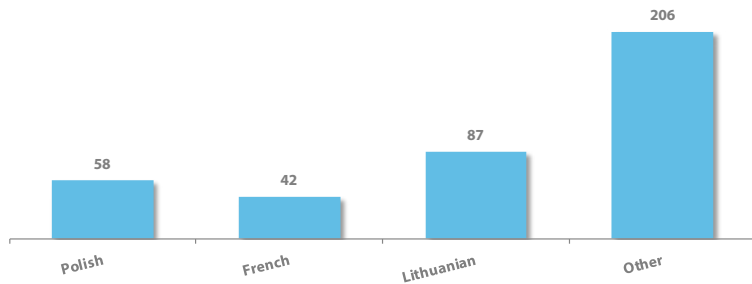

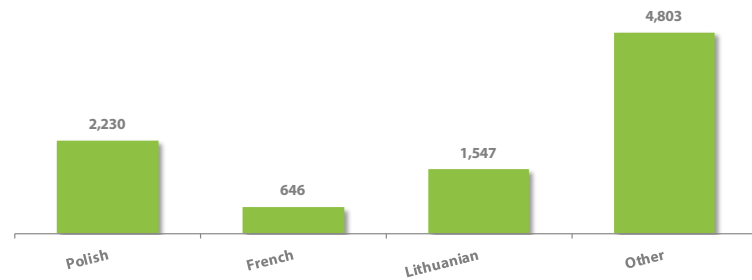

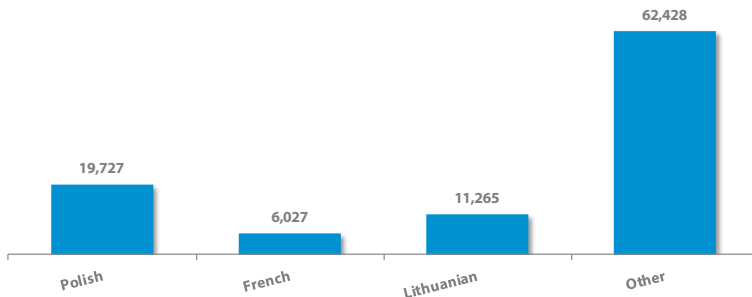

Within a thirty minute drivetime there is a labour force of 37,685. This figure represents approximately 1.6% of the labour force of Ireland (2.3M) in 2016.

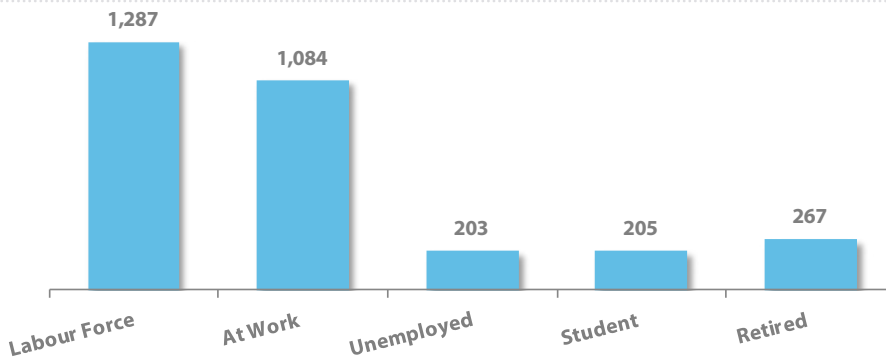

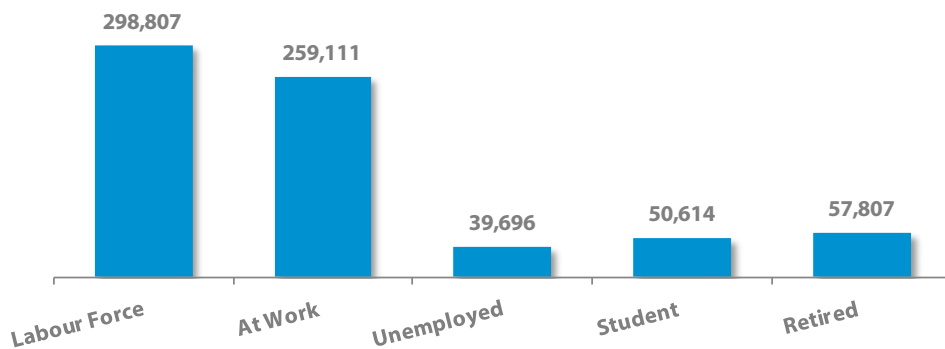

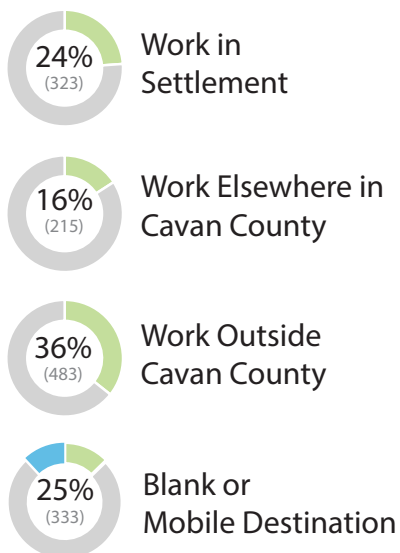
Resident Workers and Locally based Jobs

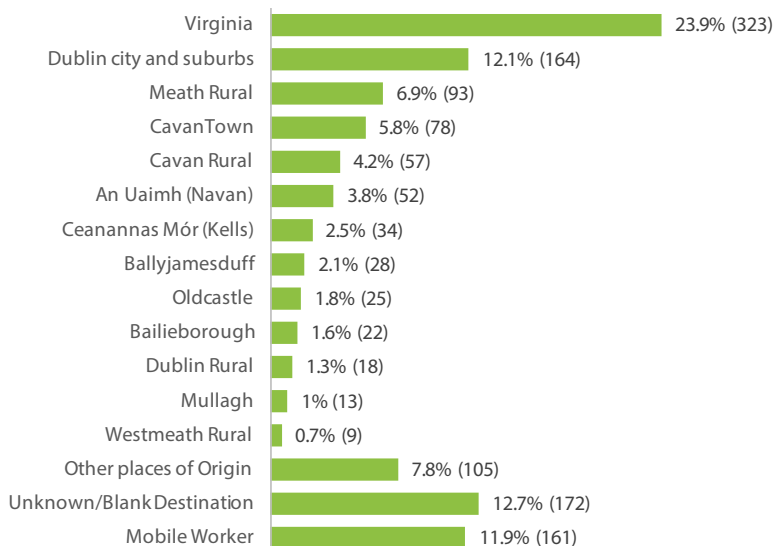


Where are Virginia resident workers (1,354) employed?

Destination of Virginia Residents Workers - by Settlement*

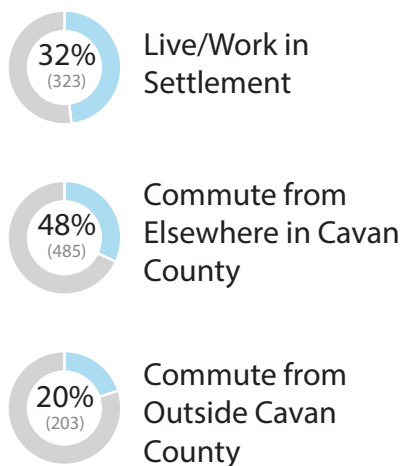

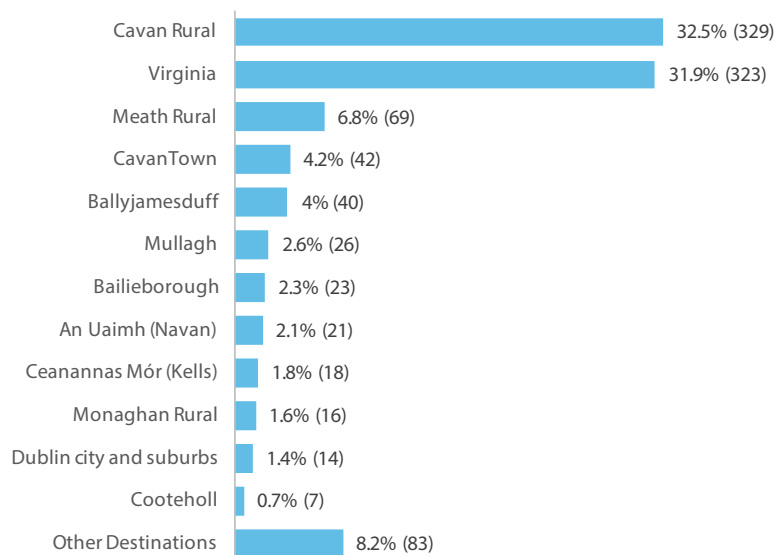
Virginia based Jobs - where do workers come from? (1,011)

There are 1,354 people residing in the Virginia settlement area who are classed as being 'At Work'. Of these workers, a total of 24% (323) are employed in Virginia, 16% (215) are employed elsewhere in Cavan, 36% (483) commute out of the county for employment and the remaining 25% (333) are either Mobile workers or have a blank or un-codeable destination.



In total, there are 1,011 jobs located within the Virginia settlement. Of these, 32% (323) are undertaken by local residents living in Virginia, 48% (485) are undertaken by workers living elsewhere in Cavan county (see Map on following page) and the remaining 20% (203) are undertaken by workers who commute to Virginia from outside the county.

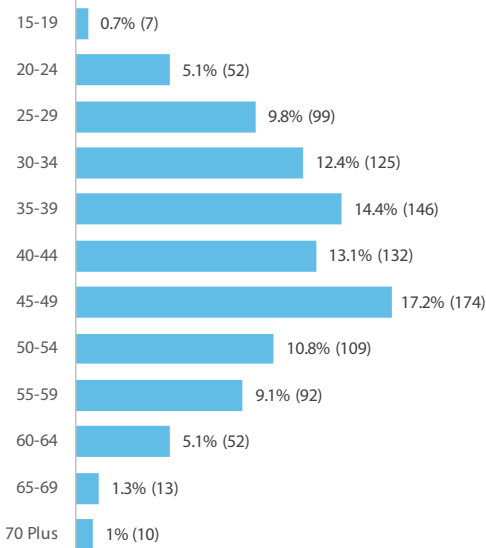

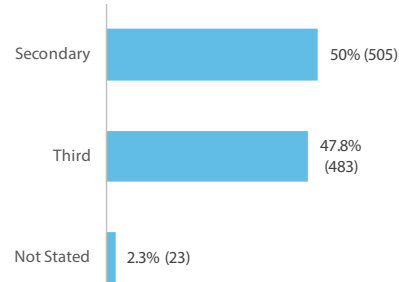

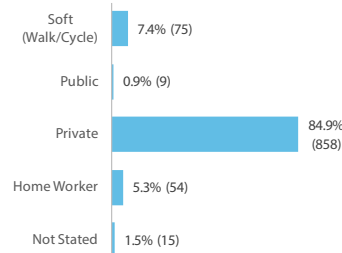

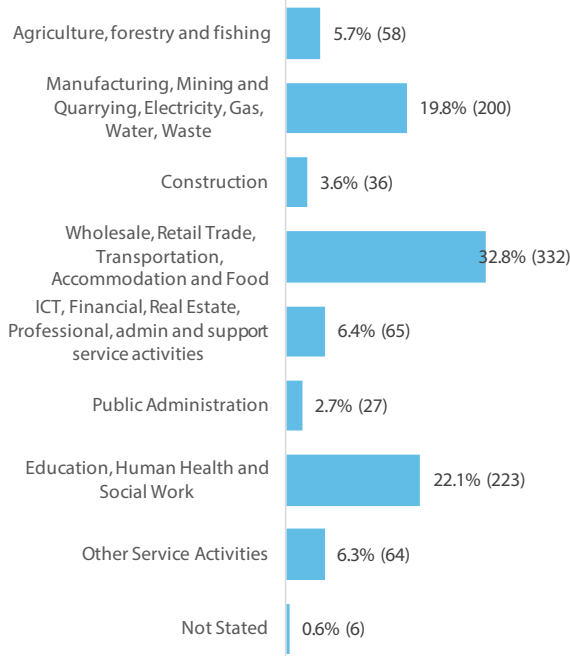

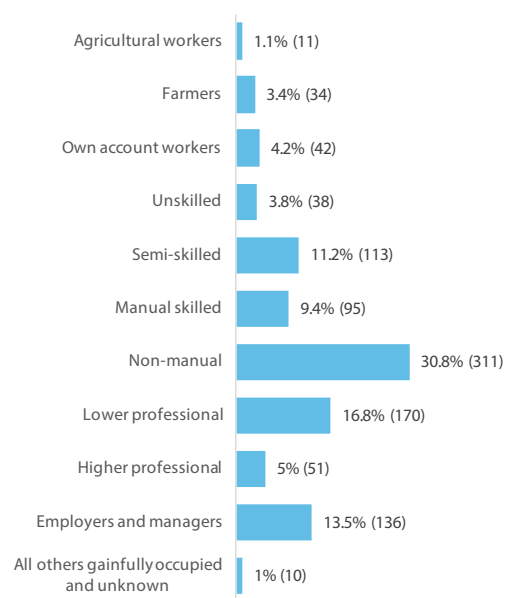

According to POWCAR 2016, there are 1,011 jobs based in Virginia. This accounts for 4.9% of all jobs based in the county. Although 52% of the resident workers in Virginia are employed elsewhere (see previous page), Virginia is the employment destination for 688 workers from outside the settlement. The town is a net exporter of jobs (-343).

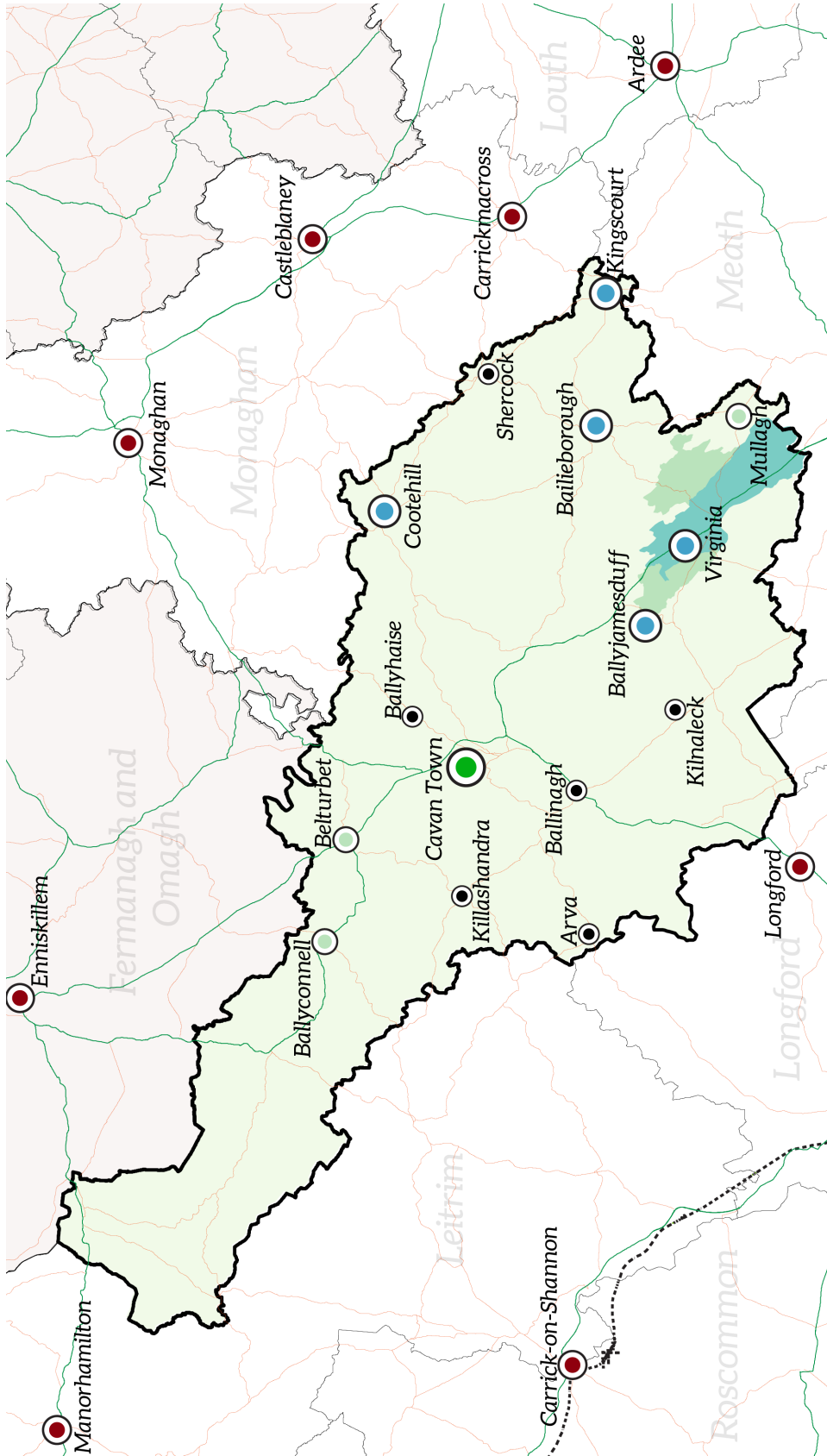

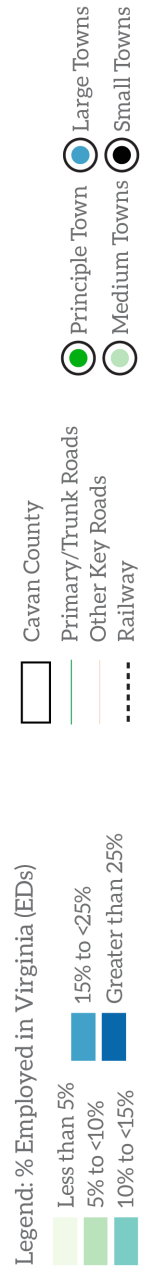
