Leaving Gortalughany car park we will follow the trail onto the reserve to the area of Leggacurragh Gap through both blanket bog and limestone areas you'll need suitable footwear and clothing to take part; please note the walk will not be to the summit of the mountain. We hope to see Skylark, Meadow Pipit, peat-nesting Sand Martins and perhaps birds of prey, typical blanket bog plants and the rare Moonwort; we will also see some of the geological features and go into a small cave. 
